GILL AGGREGATES, NORTHFLEET, KENT

KKB were commissioned to set-up an aggregate bagging and distribution centre.

The 1.2 hectare site had previously been used as a storage area for silt washings generated during aggregate production from Cemex wharf.

We relocated approximately fifty thousand cubic metres of the silt to extend the site's current noise bund and create space for the works.

The site formation was cement stabilised prior to be overlaid with cement-bound aggregate generated from waste from the adjoining block production facility.

A sludge lagoon was back-filled with lime and cement stabilised waste before being overlaid with CBM and 50mm stone mastic asphalt surfacing.
