

# CASE STUDY



## UNIVERSITY OF THE ARTS LONDON, KINGS CROSS

KKB were involved in the redevelopment of a former granary building situated adjacent to the Grand Union Canal and London King's Cross Station.

The Grade II listed former industrial complex is being converted into a new University campus for Central Saint Martins College of Art and Design.

Our two metre excavation removed concrete slabs and exposed eighty railway turntables. The hardcore was screened and crushed on-site and used for creating piling mats and sub-base for adjoining access roads.

We worked with the London Borough of Camden's Archaeology Department to carefully expose the sites' heritage features
