

CASE STUDY



POLICE INTERVIEW CENTRE, GREAT YARMOUTH

KKB were appointed to help enable a former industrial site for the development of a Police Interview Centre to be shared by the Norfolk and Suffolk Constabularies.

The site has previously been occupied by oil exploration company, Brown & Root, and hydrocarbon hotspots and asbestos contamination had been identified in the environmental survey.

More than 500 cubic metres of land was excavated and decontaminated of hydrocarbons using bioremediation and lime stabilisation.

Groundwater was pumped to a mobile treatment centre where pollutants were removed.

Two thousand cubic metres of soil was decontaminated of asbestos and over ten thousand cubic metres of hardcore created by the excavation were crushed on-site and processed into type 1.

We also prepared hybernacules to re-house several brown lizards caught on the site to retain its biodiversity.
